
### Technology Considerations for Online Visual Process Work



### Specialized Hardware

Pen Display
(interactive)
such as
Wacom Cintiq



Graphics Tablet
(opaque)
such as
Wacom Intuos



Acts as second display for computer that you draw on and see what you're drawing

Acts as "input device" for computer

– you see what you draw on your

computer monitor only

# Take advantage of hardware and software configurations and abilities

#### **Hardware**

Most input devices will have operating software that can be configured to make the best use of options available with your drawing software Some input devices have physical buttons that can be programmed for specific tasks

# Drawing Software

Most apps will have preferences that can be configured to make the app work in ways that suit your workflow the best – find them and use them

### Keyboard Hotkeys

Most computer apps have keystrokes or combinations of keystrokes that can be memorized (or modified) to make some tasks much easier – learn them and use them

Overall ease of use for online Visual Coaching:	will probably slow things down a little due to placement of paper (and hands) for sharing live work or moments in progress	eye-hand coordination can be <u>very</u> difficult to master when writing or drawing quickly	a good quality pen display is the best option available at this time	only an option if using external monitor, since map and video can't be viewed by coach at the same time	requires connecting to a computer to run meeting or could join meeting with tablet as the third attendee and share the tablet with the map *
